

Background of ED-UNZA Scholarship Trust

The ED UNZA scholarship program was established by His Excellency, the President of The Republic of Zimbabwe, Dr Emmerson Dambudzo Mnangagwa in his personal capacity on November 27, 2019 with the broad objective of addressing inequalities in terms of accessing high quality tertiary education amongst underprivileged but academically gifted youths who have demonstrated academic proficiency in their studies.

The scholarship program has a national outlook designed to benefit highly gifted students from impecunious backgrounds who would have excelled in their Advanced Level Studies with 13 points or better.

The program benefits learners from each of the country's 10 provinces in Zimbabwe as well as underprivileged Zambian students on a student exchange arrangement. Beneficiaries of this nascent initiative will pursue studies in law, medicine and sciences.

Students under the scholarship program are guided by a code of conduct which stipulates some of the objectives listed below which each student is required to know before submitting their application form:

- The Scholarship fund is purely for academic purposes and it will cater for academic issues only and anything outside that will not be entertained.
- The fund will cover tuition for the period of study, accommodation, transport at the beginning and end of the year, health care insurance, study permit and a monthly stipend. A laptop will be provided as a once-off provision upon enrolment into the first semester of first year. (Textbooks and other study material will remain a property of the scholarship program and will be surrendered to the trust upon completion of studies).



- Students under this program are expected to respect and uphold the objectives or rules of the University/Country and **not** to behave in a manner that may be harmful to the reputation of the University.
- Students are expected to act responsibly and to refrain from conduct that may be detrimental to the reputation and good name of the Patron of the Scholarship Fund.
- Over and above, the students are expected to excel in their studies and in the event of non-performance by any student, the trustees have a discretion to exclude the student from the program.

12. Eligibility Requirements

The aim of the ED UNZA Scholarship Program is to allow motivated and successful students, who lack the needed financial resources, to pursue higher education. In order to be eligible for a scholarship:-



- The applicant must have between 13 and 15 Advanced Level points.
- Attach O'level and A'level results
- Priority shall be given to orphans and indigent students.
- A detailed social background of the applicant should be attached
- Application should be accompanied by supporting letter from school headmaster.
- Application should be accompanied by copy of birth certificate, death certificate, I.D of applicant, supporting letters from Headman or Chief, who shall support what the school authorities would have provided as proof of the indigent position of the student.
- Provision of false information or any misrepresentation will disqualify your application.

Please make sure to meet eligibility requirements before submitting your application, and attach the required documentation. Applicants who do not meet the eligibility requirements and/or fail to submit the required documentation will not be considered.
